

Programme of Major Events & Services in 2025



2025 marks 150 years since Christ Church was opened for public worship on 13th May 1875.

To commemorate this anniversary, we have planned a programme of special services, events and celebrations across 2025, as well as some new groups and initiatives - with a particular focus on the week of the 11^{th} – 18^{th} May.

Much of the emphasis will inevitably be in and around the church itself; but we also want to use this anniversary to put Christ Church back at the heart of our community (as it was at its foundation and for many decades) and rediscover that missionary zeal of our founder Charles Lyndhurst Vaughan.

As well as welcoming the community to regular open days and other events, a central plank of our celebrations will be an ambitious fundraising programme with a goal of raising £21,000 over the course of the year. Mindful of the Christian imperative to love our neighbours as ourselves – and Our Lord's clear teaching that all are our neighbours – we intend to split what we raise three ways:



Christ Church

One third will go towards a project to restore and replace the sacred vestments of Christ Church, many of which have now sadly come to the end of their life. Their use is central in the offering of the Mass, which is itself at the heart of our life and worship: this project will ensure that we can continue to offer worship of the Lord in the beauty of holiness for generations to come.

Our neighbours in the community: St Michael's Hospice

One third will be donated to St Michael's Hospice, who do incredible work in our local community to ensure the dignity of every person in the final stages of their life.

Our neighbours overseas: the Church in Tanzania

One third will go to support the work of the Church overseas amongst some of the poorest in the world, focussed on the work of the Church in Tanzania where Christ Church has historic links.

Current fundraising plans include parish quizzes, a sponsored pilgrimage, sponsored lifting at the gym - and even sponsored sobriety from the Rector!

This year we'll also be re-founding some of the traditional guilds to organise the huge amount of volunteering work that goes on to keep Christ Church running, and place them under the patronage of some of our parish saints – including **St Thérèse of Lisieux** and **St Frances de Sales**. We will launch **annual guild dinners** to thank all of our volunteers for their hard work throughout the year.



Music

Our centrepiece new offering will be 'Second Sundays at Christ Church': Choral Evensong & Benediction, followed by supper with a guest speaker. Our first will be on Sunday 11th May in our anniversary week.

We also look forward to launching a new partnership with the Hastings Philharmonic Choir & Orchestra as part of our music programme, which will include free lunchtime concerts on Saturdays from May.

We also will bless and dedicate our new Chapel of St Peter & St Paul, which uses the old altar from the former church that is now part of our parish – complementing the Chapel of St Mary Magdalen which provides our link with that former church. It will be an ongoing focus for our ecumenical efforts to build links and grow relationships with other churches and Christians in St Leonards & Hastings.

In addition, we will be commissioning and installing a new Confessional, made by a local craftsman from re- and upcycled materials, as well as offering regular contemplative Taizé prayer & an Alpha course for those interested in exploring the Faith.
